## ON CAMPUS UPDATES

**Sunday School and after school hangouts on Wednesday afternoons have resumed!** For Wednesdays, this includes bus pickup from participating schools (check with me if you are unsure which schools the route runs to) and a light church wide meal at 5:15 pm. **Students will be dismissed after dinner at 6:00 pm and must be picked up/have parental permission to leave by 6:15 pm.** We will have an online Zoom hangout from 7:00 pm - 8:30 pm.

1. **To ride the bus or attend any student ministry meeting/event on or off campus, every current student in the ministry must turn in an updated, notarized permission form at least THREE DAYS BEFORE** being able to attend an event or ride the bus! I can notarize the permission form if you need a notary, and we can schedule a time that works for you for me to notarize it!
2. **I need to know which students plan on riding the bus from school to the after school program THREE DAYS BEFORE the day you plan to ride the bus** to make sure they are on the bus list. This list is necessary for the bus driver and bus rider volunteers to know who is expected to ride, and so they can watch out and wait for student(s) to be counted when transporting them to the church.

**\*Without notification and a signed and notarized permission form, students will not be allowed to ride the bus or participate in any in-person student ministry events or hangouts.**

## CURRENT SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

With so many cases of COVID still happening in our community, we will be taking precautions to care for and look after one another as best we can by practicing the recommended guidelines like wearing a mask and social distancing among those living in different households as a way to care for and show Christ's love to one another!

1. **Please do not attend in-person events if you are feeling sick** or experiencing a fever, runny nose, cough, sore throat, or showing any other signs of sickness. We will notify parents/guardians to have sick students picked up/sent home. Temperatures will be taken as deemed necessary.  
**\*Please do not attend if you have been sent home sick from school or did not attend school due to sickness.**
2. **Please do not attend in-person events if you have been in close proximity to someone who has tested positive for COVID in the last 10 days**
3. **We strongly encourage students and leaders to bring and wear a mask** regardless of vaccine status so that we can all protect others and their families as much as possible out of self-sacrificial, Christ like love.
4. **Masks and hand sanitizer stations will be available.**
5. **Church-wide air filtration systems and a small air purifying unit** in the student ministry room.
6. Individually wrapped **snacks and drinks will be safely placed in tamper proof bags and opened/eaten outside when possible.**
7. **Digital (and some active) games where students and leaders touch as few of the same objects as possible.**
8. **Respect others' space and follow social distancing rules** (6ft distance from others and no physical contact).
9. **Be extra kind, encouraging, and understanding during this time** since so many people have been affected in both big and small ways relationally and emotionally during this season of life.
